She received her doctorate in 1971 at the University of Salzburg, and continued studying at the University of Zurich in Switzerland and the University of Paris I from 1977 to 1989, where she received a doctorate in 1986. She also studied at the University of Vienna and the University of Munich. After the death of her husband, she moved to Salzburg. She taught at the University of Salzburg from 1989 to 2005. She died in Salzburg.
